BABES ON BAFFIN AND BLUE TOURNAMENT RULES 2011

Anyone entering this Tournament will be required to abide by these Tournament Rules. Anyone found to have deviated from the Rules will be disqualified from the Tournament and all future tournaments hosted by CCA. Any protest must be received by the Tournament Director within 15 minutes following the 4:00 pm Weigh-in Deadline. Participants are responsible for knowing, understanding, and abiding by these Rules. Questions and comments concerning any Rule may be directed to the Tournament Director. In all Tournament matters, the Tournament Director's decisions are final. Prior to the Tournament, email any questions through the web page www.babesonbaffin.com.

Ladies Only- This is a woman only fishing tournament.

Team – A team can be up to 4 women with one guide / driver. All individuals on the boat must be listed on the registration form and have paid the applicable entry fees.

Release – Each team member and the guide / driver must sign a Tournament Release prior to the Tournament Start Time.

Tournament Start Time - Fishing begins at official sunrise on Saturday, October 8th. Time of official sunrise will be posted at Check-In on Friday evening.

Tackle - Live or artificial bait allowed only in Divisions 1 and 3.

One Pole per Angler – You can have more than one rod and reel on the boat, but you cannot fish with more than one pole at a time.

Assistance – You may be assisted with baiting your hook, casting, and netting but you must “set the hook” and reel the fish to the boat or net.

Boat Fishing Only – A team may fish from two boats but they must remain in sight of one another. No jetty, surf, dock or pier fishing. Fishing can be from any inshore waters. You may launch from anywhere.

Eligible Fish - Eligible Fish are legal size Trout, Redfish, and Black Drum only. **No over-sized fish will be judged.** In the event of a length tie, weight prevails. Decisions of the Tournament Weigh Master are final.

Weigh-in Deadline – Weigh-in is no earlier than 12:00 noon; the penalty-free Weigh-in Deadline is 4:00 pm. During Friday's check-in, each team will be assigned a team number. When arriving for weigh-in, each boat must visually check in with the Dock Master stationed on the dock by passing close to the dock and visually displaying the team number card to the Dock Master. Each team should ensure it gets a confirmation acknowledgement from the Dock Master. Once check-in confirmation is given by the Dock Master, each team should wait in their boat until their team number is called to proceed to an available off loading space and then to the weigh-in / measurement area with their bagged fish where a circulation tank will be available. If a team has not checked in with the Dock Master by 4:00 pm, the team will be penalized at the rate of 1) ½ inch for each full minute late deducted from the cumulative Team Stringer length and from the length of any individual fish award contender, and, 2) ½ ounce for each full minute late deducted from the weight of any individual fish contender for a cash pot. Any team that has not checked in with the Dock Master by 4:15 pm will be disqualified, no exceptions. Each team must be respectful of other teams who are off loading or waiting to off load, this includes not tying off in the area designated for boats to off load. Boats must be removed from the dock area immediately following off loading. If the Dock Master asks a team or an individual team member to move a boat or leave the off loading area and it doesn't, the team will be disqualified.

Live Weigh-in Bonus – Each live fish presented at weigh-in will receive a ½ inch bonus added to the cumulative Team Stringer length and to the length of any individual fish award contender, and, ½ ounce added to the weight of any individual fish contender for a cash pot. At weigh-in, anglers can indicate their donation of the live fish to TPWD where they will be used for brood stock or placed in the kid fish pond. A circulation tank will be on-site and circulation fish bags can be made available.

Redfish – A legal Redfish (Red Drum) must be at least 20” and not greater than 28”. If you catch one smaller than 20” by law you are required to release it. You cannot weigh-in a Redfish over 28”. A Redfish over 28” must be tagged if you decide to keep it. **Your team must decide which Redfish to weigh in prior to approaching the Weigh Master.**

Trout – A legal Trout (Spotted Seatrout) must be at least 15”. If you catch one smaller than 15” by law you are required to release it. You cannot weigh-in a Trout over 25”. **Your team must decide which Trout to weigh in prior to approaching the Weigh Master.**

Black Drum – A legal Drum (Black Drum) must be at least 14” and not greater than 30”. If you catch one smaller than 14” by law you are required to release it. You cannot weigh-in a Drum over 30”. **Your team must decide which Drum to weigh in prior to approaching the Weigh Master.**

Team Stringer - A maximum Team Stringer consists of one Trout, one Redfish, and one Black Drum. Only these three fish can be presented to the Weigh Master at weigh-in. If you have a second Redfish eligible for Most Spots, also present that fish to the Weigh Master. No more than these four fish can be brought to the weigh-in.

Fishing License – All Texas Parks and Wildlife Rules and Regulations apply. You must have a valid/current fishing license with a saltwater stamp from Texas Parks and Wildlife to fish in this tournament. If you catch a Redfish that is greater than 28”, and you decide to keep it, you need to tag the fish (part of your license). Each angler is allowed one tagged Red per year. You can purchase a 1-day all water license which comes with a tag. **You must fish the tournament by the TPW rules. Citations for not observing the rules disqualify the team from the Tournament.**

Polygraph - All entrants are subject to polygraph testing. Failure to take and/or pass the test will result in disqualification. Results of the polygraph are final. The individual taking the test may be a team member or the guide/boat driver. If the angler is a minor, a parent or legal guardian shall agree for the minor to submit to such polygraph testing.

Sportsmanship – Any angler, who displays poor sportsmanship, violates any Tournament Rule, or any state or local game laws will be disqualified without refund or recourse. In addition, any act of an angler, verbal or physical, that reflects unfavorably upon CCA’s effort to promote conservation, fishing, clean waters, courtesy, and safety shall be reason for disqualification from this and all future CCA tournaments.

Natural Disaster - In the event of a natural disaster, the Tournament may be postponed and rescheduled for a later date. No refunds will be given.

RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE

For good and valuable consideration, including without limitation the acceptance of the undersigned's entry or participation in the Babes on Baffin and Blue fishing tournament (the "Event") and being permitted to participate in certain related activities, the undersigned, for herself and her personal representatives, heirs, guest, invitees, employees, and team or crew members hereby

(1) RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES, AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE Coastal Conservation Association or its Chapters, subsidiaries, related entities, respective members, volunteers, heirs, successors, assigns, officers, directors, employees, agents, contractors and subcontractors (collectively, the "Releasees") from any and all liability to the undersigned, her personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin, and for all loss or damage, and all claims or damages therefore, on account of bodily injury, personal injury, death, property or other damage of or to the undersigned, her guests, invitees, employees, team or crew, during the Event or arising out of or in any way in connection with the Event or its Rules or related activities or while the undersigned is competing, or participating, regardless of whether caused in whole or in part by the negligence of Releasees;

(2) AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Releasees and each of them from and against all claims, actions, causes of action, damages, liabilities, losses and judgments (collectively, the "Claims") of or by all guests, invitees, employees, and team or crew of the undersigned for bodily injury, personal injury, death, property or other damage which they may suffer or incur during the Event or arising out of or in any way in connection with the Event or its Rules or related activities, regardless of whether caused in whole or in part by the negligence of Releasees; and,

(3) ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY for the risk or occurrence of bodily injury, personal injury, death, property or other damage of or to herself, her guests, invitees, employees, and team or crew and to her boat and equipment due to negligence of Releasees or otherwise during the Event or while participating in the Event or related activities or while in or on the Event premises, which includes but is not limited to, its common properties, recreational areas, and adjacent docks, piers, and boat slips.

The undersigned agrees to pay all of the Releasees' costs of defending all Claims and further agrees that this Release, Hold Harmless and Agreement Not to Sue is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Texas and that, if any portion of this agreement is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
